Neil's degrees are all in forestry: a BS from Cook College/Rutgers University, a Master's in Forest Science from the University of New Hampshire, and a PhD in Forest Ecology and Silviculture from Yale School of Forestry and Environmental Studies. He spent several years as a faculty member in the graduate program in resource management at Simon Fraser University, British Columbia, Canada. For the last twenty years, he has been a practicing arborist. In his position as Northeast Technical Representative for the R.A. Bartlett Tree Research Laboratories in Charlotte, NC, he conducts research, provides technical support for Bartlett throughout the country and internationally, and does numerous lectures and workshops for both the green industry and other interested groups. He is a Certified Arborist, NJ Certified Tree Expert, and a member of the Society of American Foresters."
